## WHAT WILL THEY THINK OF NEXT? A POINT BY POINT DISCUSSION OF THE MOST RECENT NASBA EDUCATION PROPOSAL

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## **ABSTRACT**

First, the Accounting Education Change Commission encouraged academics to get students more active in the learning process. Most recently the American Institute of CPAs has called upon accounting educators to work with various teaching styles to allow students to learn more process skills. Then we had all the scandals with Enron, Global Crossing, et al. The politicians were busy legislating morality and ethics with Sarbanes-Oxley. Now, the National Association of State Boards of Accountancy is proposing drastic changes in accounting education for non-AACSB accredited universities.
