

THE USE OF THE LEARNING ACTIVITY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (LAMS) IN POST-GRADUATE TEACHING

ABSTRACT

This abstract relates to a paper that describes the use and problems associated with a web-based learning design program called the Learning Activity Management System (LAMS) in the teaching at a postgraduate management school. The paper briefly describes the operation of LAMS and provides an introduction to its features. Next the paper discusses the pedagogical dimensions of the technology and the political concerns with its application within the teaching of post graduate classes within a cultural environment that highlights the dominance of face-to-face teaching methodologies.
