ABSTRACT

Evidence-based practice (EBP) for nursing shows hospital management the monetary value of existing research using Meta-analysis The nursing shortage can be reduced if unnecessary non-value added traditional practices contraindicated by research are eliminated thus adding value to patient outcomes. Projects apply EBP to specific areas, such as fall prevention, ventilator sedation, and bereavement improvement for end of life issues.
